Harvest Fayre 9th September!

Finally, after months of planning our Harvest Fayre Summer Event has arrived. This year the summer event has been scaled up significantly by moving the event to the Paddock next to Chipping Hall with direct access off the A10. The Banners are already in place as I sure many of you will have seen.

The extra space has allowed a much larger event to be staged in keeping with other events hosted by neighboring Villages. This year you can expect to see a wide variety of food stalls, Plant stalls and Craft Stalls, along with amusement rides for young Children. Entertainment will be provided by a staged band along with a Bar serving a variety of drinks and vendors offering Coffee, Teas, soft Drinks, and cakes too.

We will be raising money for the fantastic Isabel Hospice and to help with the upkeep of the Parish.
