Buckland and Chipping Parish Council will be taking part in the nationwide 80th anniversary of D-Day celebration.



## **HertsLynx Community Bus Service**

It worth reminding everyone about the fantastic on demand community bus service HertsLynx. First launched in North & East Herts in September 2021. The service provides transport to residents in a designated operating zone, as well as providing transport links to fixed destinations in Key Hub Towns: Stevenage, Letchworth, Hitchin, Baldock, Royston and Bishop's Stortford. Now due to popular demand, the East and North service has now expanded to include Hertford and Ware too.

#### How can I create a HertsLynx account?

Once you have downloaded the HertsLynx app.

- 1. Click on the "Sign Up" button.
- 2. Enter your email address, your mobile phone number, first name, surname, and the password you would like to use for your HertsLynx account.
- 3. Select the box to agree to the Terms & Conditions.
- 4. There will be a one-time security check for account registrations that will appear on the page.
- 5. Click register.
- 6. If you have entered a mobile phone number, you will be sent a telephone validation code by SMS, enter this code to validate your phone number and complete your account set up.
