On Monday 13th May the Parish Council met at St Andrews Church to hold both the Annual Parish meeting and the Annual Parish Council meeting. As is usual at this time of year Our departing Chair Helen Dauris provided a report of the year's events. Part of which is repeated here in summary only..

Buckland & Chipping Parish Council has had another busy year. Undoubtedly the highlights were the first Harvest Fayre Summer Event which took place so successfully during September in Chipping. The inaugural Parish Pimms Evening took place in Buckland last July and of course the monthly group Rambles. In August we held a fund-raising event for the Breast Cancer Now charity, followed in November by our annual Bonfire and Fireworks event. As usual the event was a real winter success. It was great to see so many parishioners there enjoying the fine bonfire and the impressive fireworks as well as the traditional barbecue. We also had a peaceful Remembrance Day Ceremony in St Andrew's Church, which gave everyone who came some welcome moments for reflection. And, in the run up to Christmas, the lovely annual Carols by Candlelight service also took place here in St Andrew's.

As part of usual Parish business in May, we elected the Parish Council for the coming year. Cllr Robert Arkle was elected as Chairman, Cllr Penny Newman as Vice Chair, together with Cllr Jeffrey Kenyon, Cllr Helen Dauris, Cllr Debbie Thompson, Cllr Simon Dela- Nougrede and Parish Clerk Caroline Scott completing the Council.

80th anniversary of D-Day celebration report

On Thursday 6th June we joined with other Villages, towns, cities, and organisations to mark the 80th anniversary of D-Day with the lighting of our new beacon and reading of the special tribute. The same tribute was read around the United Kingdom, Channel Islands, Isle of Man and UK overseas territories. This was in celebration of the 'light of peace' that emerged out of the darkness of war.



As the passage of rememberance tribute closed, the "Last Post" echoed through the common. We also celebrated our hard won freedoms with Free Fish and Chips for all those who attended.

Jazz music, 40's classics and original BBC News broadcasts of the 6th June 1944 provided a nostalgic ambience. Thank you to everyone who attended and for those who helped organise the event. The Beacon was made locally for the Parish by blacksmith Lucas Ling. The beacon will now be a permanent feature on the common.
